REGISTRATION INFORMATION

It's Official!!: Wilshire & Riverside Little Leagues are one league.

ELIGIBILITY: Boys at league ages 5 through 14. Girls at ages 5 through 14. Players must also live within League boundaries (see map on back).

Baseball: The child's League Age is their actual age as of **April 30, 2011**
(examples: DOB is 4/30/05, child is League age 6; DOB is 5/1/05, child is League age 5).

Softball: The child's League Age is their actual age as of **December 31, 2010**
(examples: DOB is 12/31/03, child is League Age 7 and softball farm league ready; DOB is 01/01/04, child is League Age 6 play baseball – use baseball age cutoff dates).

REGISTRATION:

In-person registration on **January 20 & 26, 2011: 6:30 pm to 8:30 pm** at Alameda Elementary School, 2732 NE Fremont.

NEW PLAYERS MUST PROVIDE: 1. Completed Registration Form with Medical Information, 2. Copy of Birth Certificate; 3. Proof of Residency* (Check, utility bill, driver's license, voter registration.) 4. Payment. **RETURNING PLAYERS (with info on file) NEED ONLY PROVIDE:** 1. Completed Registration Form with Medical Information; 2. Payment.

*If you played for Wilshire Riverside Little League and lived within league boundaries in 2010 but have moved outside of the boundary and still wish to play for the league in 2011, please be prepared to complete required form 2d waiver paperwork.

COST: \$80 per player, maximum \$150 for two or more siblings, per season. No player will be turned away for inability to pay. Contact John McAllister, League Treasurer at 503-493-3525 to discuss scholarship from the league or payment terms.

AVAILABLE PROGRAMS (General Guidelines – All Player Placements Are At League Discretion)

T-Ball - Boys & Girls; League Ages 5-7

Baseball - Boys & Girls; League Ages 7-14

Farm League (Pitching Machine): Boys & Girls; League Age 8-10 OR League Age 7 with 1 Year Little League T-Ball **AND** can safely compete (fielding & batting).

Minor League: Boys & Girls; League Ages 9-11; **Must Attend Player Evaluations**

Any 9-10 year old player not drafted to a Minor League team will be placed on a Farm League team.

Major League: Boys & Girls; League Ages 10-12; **Must Attend Player Evaluations**

Any 11 year old player not drafted to a Major League team will be drafted to a Minor League Team. 12 year olds will be drafted to a Major League team.

Juniors: Boys & Girls; League Ages 13-14; **Team Formations based on age or as determined by VP of Juniors Baseball**

Exceptions to league age for a given division must be approved by the board, i.e. 6 yr old farm, 8 yr old minor, 10 yr old major)

Softball - Girls; League Ages 7-14

Farm League (Pitching Machine): Girls; League Age 8-10 OR League Age 7 with 1 Year Little League T-Ball **AND** can safely compete (fielding & batting).

Minor League: Girls; League Ages 9-11

Major League: Girls; League Ages 10-12

Juniors: Girls; League Ages 13-14

Challenger - Boys & Girls Ages 5-15 for mentally &/or physically disabled youth. Wilshire Riverside Board Members will put you in contact with Oregon District #1 Challenger Little League rep.

BASEBALL PLAYER EVALUATIONS: Evaluations will be held February 26 & 27 at Beaumont Middle School rain or shine. Hitting and fielding evaluations are held for coaches to preview player's abilities and assist in properly assigning players to teams. All players league ages 9-12 **MUST** attend evaluations to be placed on a Minor or Major league team. See schedule of evaluation sessions on back of this page for times and age levels.

VOLUNTEERS: The League belongs to you and your family. For each season to run smoothly the League depends on parent volunteers to make this a great experience for our children. **All parents are required to work in the concession stand for at least one (1) shift, per player, each season.** Complete the volunteer form in-person or online.

OPENING DAY: Saturday, **April 2, 2011**, includes our FREE annual Pancake Breakfast from 7:30-9:00 am at Riverside Field (rain or shine - breakfast is under cover). Ceremonies start at 9:30 am.

Other General Information / Frequently Asked Questions:

Teams will be formed and players notified by the second week in March for Minors & Majors. Managers and Coaches will contact players and families to notify them of their team, practice schedule, etc.

T-Ball & Farm team formations will continue through March. It is our goal to have this process complete before Statewide Spring Break with coaches and teams determined no later than March 18, 2011.

Game schedules for all levels should be available on or before Opening Day. Typical game schedule include one weekday and one Saturday game. Practice schedule days and duration vary by division. Coaches will provide information about practice, game time and location. Practice and/or game fields may include Wilshire, Beaumont, Riverside, Irving, Alameda, Sabin, Rigler, Fernhill, Alberta Park, Faubion and Woodlawn.

The league provides a uniform hat & jersey. Upper divisions include pants, belt & socks. Player provide their own glove. Teams will be provided with bats, balls, helmet, and catcher's equipment. Players may bring their own catcher's gear as long as it is Little League approved.

T-ball, Farm & Minor divisions will play teams within Wilshire Riverside Little League. Majors, Juniors and all Softball levels will play teams from surrounding Little Leagues.
